

WHITE ELEPHANT GIFT EXCHANGE

What is it? It is a gift exchange of one of your least liked possessions (please no spouses). It could be something you received as a gift or just something you have around the house or motor home that you've wondered how to get rid of it. It could be an old dress, tie, old picture, old RV part, old tea pot, ect. Use your imagination and be creative! If you must purchase a gift, keep the amount below ten dollars. The stranger the gift the better the party!

Must I wrap it up? Yes, it may be gift wrapped or it can also be in a brown paper grocery bag or just in an old sealed box. What ever you choose, it must be concealed from inspection with no name of the gift giver on the package.

Who can play? All couples that contributed a "gift" may play, but only one "gift" per couple.

Rules of play:

- 1.** The player who has drawn #1 goes first. He/she chooses a gift from the gift pile opens it and keeps it for the time being.
- 2.** #2 goes next and chooses an unopened gift or steals the opened gift from #1.
- 3.** Each subsequent number either opens a new gift or steals a gift that has been previously opened. If someone's gift has been stolen they may select a new gift or steal an opened gift.
- 4.** This stealing continues until a new gift is opened and then we proceed to the next number. A gift is considered "dead" once it has been stolen three times.
- 5.** After all turns have been taken, the person who had been #1 has the option of taking one more turn since they had the disadvantage of not knowing what any of the gifts where. They may not steal any "dead" gifts nor steal back a gift taken from them.
